The regular meeting of the Town of Porter Planning Board was called to order at 7:09 p.m. with the Pledge to the Flag.

Renewal -- Sketch Plan and recommendation to the ZBA for Laurence and Christina Elia (Lakewood LLC), 433 Lake Road, Youngstown; for Special Use Permit (Banquet/Event operations).

Larry Elia was present to represent the application.

Chairperson Fox explained that this application is a renewal of a Special Use Permit. The previous permit was for 5 years. He asked Mr. Elia if there were any changes and Mr. Elia confirmed there were none.

Chairperson Fox asked Code Enforcer Jeffery if there were any concerns since the permit was issued and Code Enforcer Jeffery stated he received none.

Vice Chairperson Schulze asked Mr. Elia approximately how many events have been hosted on the property since the permit was issued. He estimated 3 outdoor events a year but would like to keep the permit as issued (10 a year) for flexibility.

Chairperson Fox stated that the last permit was issued initially for 5 years and asked the Members what they thought about that time period being extended. The Members agreed that 10 years was reasonable. Mr. Elia appreciated the agreement.

A motion was made by Member Tower to recommend to the Zoning Board of Appeals that the Special Use Permit be renewed for 10 years. Vice Chairperson Schulze seconded the motion.
