
Enter all required information, select a convenient date/time to drop off your materials and print or save your confirmation e-mail.

Safely load materials into your vehicle, double check for items subject to additional fees, then drive to Hazman.

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

Residents may bring up to 50 pounds of household wastes at NO COST to Hazman (177 Wales Ave. Tonawanda NY). These items include oil base paint, fluorescent bulbs, spray paint, aerosols, paint thinners and stains, cleaners, pesticides, gasoline, acids/bases, glues/resins/adhesives and mercury devices.

EXCLUSIONS / EXTRA FEES

All weight over 50 pounds and all Latex Paint is subject to \$0.75/pound fee. Limit one voucher per household. Combining vouchers will not be allowed. Hazman will accept the following items for additional fees: Alkaline Batteries, Fire Extinguishers, Propane Tanks, Electronics, Tires, Smoke Detectors and Waste Oil.
