# Town of Porter Hometown Hero Banner Program 2024

### **Program Description**

Communities throughout the state are taking the opportunity to thank our military service members by displaying patriotic street side banners with their photos. The Town of Porter is pleased to announce that we are offering our own Hometown Hero Banner Program as a way to recognize the sacrifice and commitment of those who served or presently serve in the military. The banners can be purchased by friends, families, community organizations or businesses. The banners are prominently displayed from Memorial Day through the fall along main roads in the community.

#### **Banner Information**

The full-color banners are 66" by 30", double-sided, made of durable vinyl, with a patriotic theme and include the Veteran's photo. They contain the Veteran's **name**, **branch of service and conflict or era of service**. They can include their rank and special honors (KIA, DIS, MIA, POW, Medal of Honor, Purple Heart, Bronze or Silver Star), although less lettering allows us to more prominently show their name and photo so they are more clearly visible from a distance.

# **Military Requirements**

All service member banners must meet these requirements:

- 1. The sponsoring family/business/organization should be a resident of the Town of Porter, New York (includes the Village of Youngstown/hamlet of Ransomville). The service member to be recognized can also be a town resident, but this is not a requirement.
- 2. Did serve or are serving our country in Army, Marine, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Space Force, National Guard or National Reserve.
- 3. Must be serving currently, or be an honorably discharged veteran, MIA, or died in the line of service.

#### **Banner Pricing**

Each banner will cost the family or sponsor a total of \$190. This includes the banner, hardware for hanging, installation plus end of season cleaning and storage at Town Hall over the winter months. Banners will be re-hung each year at locations throughout the town until they become worn or the individual sponsor requests their return. The manufacturer and other communities estimate the banners can be displayed for about 3 years depending on conditions.

Applications are available at Town Hall or online at townofporter.net. The town requests that all applications be completed and returned with related photos and payment to Town Bookkeeper Kimberli Boyer by April 30, 2024.

## **Sponsorship/Donations**

For individuals or businesses who would like to be a sponsor without purchasing a banner, monetary donations will be used for expenses beyond the cost of the banners and hardware.

Please supply the best quality photo you have of the veteran in uniform that you wish to appear on the banner. Electronic digital photos are requested to be 600 DPI for optimal reproduction use. Photos can be mailed, left at the Town Hall to be scanned, or you can digitally scan the photo and attach it as a jpg in an email. If you provide an original picture, it will be scanned and returned to you. Please attach a self-addressed envelope to return the photo to you.
